Read 2 Samuel 12:13a

King David confessed his sin. He knew he did wrong. Is it hard for you to admit your wrong? Is it hard for you to confess sin to God? Is it hard for you to confess to someone else?

Why is it so important that we confess our sin to God? What are the consequences of not confessing our sin to God?

Romans 6:23, "For the wages of sin is death." Do you think people know they need to be saved from their sin? How do people know they need to be saved?
